ORDER

Whereas an application has been filed before this Tribunal by Sh. Jagdish Singh and Smt. Balvinder Kaur R/o 5 C/3, Vishnu Garden, New Delhi-18 bearing registration No. 2129 dated 27/04/12 against their daughter-in-law under the Maintenance and Welfare of parents and Senior Citizens Act 2007.

The Petitioner Sh. Jagdish Singh and his wife Smt. Balvinder Kaur appeared before the Tribunal alongwith their son Sh. Onkar Singh and daughter-in-law Smt. Amarjeet Kaur.

After hearing statements of all four witnesses, it came to light that there is domestic violence prevailing between daughter-in-law and mother-in-law. The parents have disowned both son and daughter-in-law from inheritance of their property.

The parents are wanted eviction of daughter-in-law Smt. Amarjeet Kaur who has two grown up children.

The Tribunal has tried to reconcile peace in the family and advised all four to have amicable relations and do minimum interference. The daughter-in-law Smt. Amarjeet Kaur should not abuse old parents and refrain from physical assault.

If another complaint received on physical/mental torture against Mrs. Amarjeet Kaur, the Tribunal warned such interference of Civil Police in the matter.

The son Sh. Onkar Singh should play a matured role as father and husband and play a pivotal role in bringing peace in the family.
