

Revised Standard Operating Procedure For Release of Land Compensation

- (i) Claimant/applicant has to submit an Application on plain paper with Court Fee stamp of Rs 1.25 affixed thereon alongwith the documents as follows:

3.	<u>Other than Recorded owners (compensation sought on the basis of Registered Sale Deed, Conveyance Deed/other valid instruments conveying transfer of title)</u>	<u>Indemnity -Bond,</u> <u>Identity Proof</u> <u>following documents:</u> 1. <u>NOC from the recorded owner.</u> 2. <u>Recorded owner has to give statement in favour of Claimant in person by appearing before LAC concerned.</u>	<u>In case where the recorded owner had executed sale deed and the recorded owner had expired, NDC and statement of Legal Heirs (established after the documents produced as in 2nd Column) has to be taken before release of payment.</u>

- (ii) Affidavit of Rs 10/- from applicant in the format attached at Appendix A.
 (iii) Khatauni/ Ownership proof duly signed by Concerned Patwari of the area.
 (iv) Copy of Identity Proof is to be submitted by the applicant which may be any of the following documents: Passport, UID/Aadhar Card, Voter ID or any other Identity Card issued by Govt. Department.
 (v) Copy of Pan Card or Form 16 as the case may be.

2. On receiving of application from the applicant, the concerned Patwari will scrutinize the particulars of applicant and Khasra Nos from Naksha Muntajmin and then submit his report for further process to Kanungo. Concerned Kanungo will thoroughly check the file and submit his report and remarks to NT (LAC)/Tehsildar (LA). After checking by NT (LAC)/Tehsildar (LA), the file be sent to Account Clerk, who checks the amount from Statement A and also once again check the above mentioned documents as correct as per SOP. If the file is found completed in all respect, Account Clerk will sent the file for approval of LAC through NT (LAC)/Tehsildar (LA). After approval of LAC, Account Clerk will prepare the cheque in favour of applicant alongwith the following documents and send the file again to LAC through NT (LAC)/Tehsildar (LA) for signatures of LAC:
- (a) Cheque
 - (b) Payment Certificate
 - (c) Counter Signatures on Account Book

3. After getting the signature on cheque by LAC, the same will be disbursed to the applicant alongwith payment certificate. The following documents will be obtained from the applicant:

- (a) A photocopy of PAN Card or Form 16 as the case may be.
- (b) Revenue Stamp of Rs 1/- affixing on receipt and signature of claimant on it.
- (c) An entry of cheque is made in Register and get it signed from the applicant.
- (d) Identity proof of all concerned at the time of release of cheque.
- (e) Obtain signature of applicant on concerned documents to verify the correctness.

4. The release of payment is subject to receiving of Payment from Land & Building Department/Requisitioning Department.
