FINAL ORDER

Dated 15/04/2014

Senior Citizens Sh. Gurbachan Singh and his wife Smt Jeet Kaur both R/o WZ-81 A/1, Gali No. 1A, Guru Nanank Nagar, New Delhi-110018 had filed an application before the Tribunal under Maintenance and Welfare of the Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007. In their application Senior Citizens stated that one of their sons Sh Pargan Singh and his wife Smt. Kawaljeet Kaur and his grown up sons Sh Davinder Sngh and Sh. Jasbir Singh (Grandsons of the Petitioners) were ill treating them and

indulging in abusive behavior both verbal and physical and due to the bad behavior of respondents. The Petitioners had disowned their Respondent son Sh.Pargan Singh and his family via a public notice published in newspaper dated 18/12/2013. The Sr. Citizen wanted protection of their life, property and vacation of the house from the Respondent Son Sh. Pargan and his family.

The Senior Citizens had no complaints against their sons Sh. Pyara Singh and Sh. Bhim Singh and infact stated that their son Sh. Pyara Singh provided them food, clothes, and look after their day to day needs. Conciliation efforts were made by the Tribunal and after final hearing on 03/04/2014, the case was closed, and the Tribunal issues the following orders.

- 1. Maintenance to be paid to the Petitioners by each of their sons, per month as follows
 - a. Sh. Pyara Singh who is already looking after the senior citizens, shall pay a maintenance amount of Rs. 1000/- per month.
 - b. Sh. Bhim Singh who is a Scooter Mechanic shall pay a maintenance amount of Rs. 2000/- per month.
 - c. Sh. Pragan Singh the Respondent, running a business with his sons Sh. Devendar Singh and Sh. Jasbir Singh having a handsome income per month shall pay a maintenance amount of Rs. 4000/- per month.

The above orders of maintenance shall be paid by each son through cheque by the 10th of every month into the account of Smt. Jeet Kaur and Sh. Gurbachan Singh vide account no. 67898 of Punjab and Sindh Bank, 43-44, New Market Tilak Nagar, New Delhi.

- 2. Each son shall pay their own share of water and electricity charges every month.
- 3. The Respondent son Sh. Pragan Singh and grandsons Sh. Davender singh and Sh. Jasbir Singh submitted that they shall withdraw civil cases filed against the petitioner Sh. Gurbachan Singh and Smt. Jeet Kaur having volunteered to do so before the Tribunal
- 4. That all the parties shall refrain from all kinds of verbal and physical abuse.
- 5. The concerned SHO to keep a vigil over the life and property of the Senior Citizensand to render to all possible help whenever approached.
