FINAL ORDER

Dated 13/03/2014

An application was filed by Sh. Om Parkash Chanana R/o L-21, New Mahavir Nagar, New Delhi-110018 before the tribunal complaining against his son Sh. Kuldeep Kumar Chanana bearing registration no. 4708 dated 08/10/2013.

In his application Sh. Om Parkash Chanana R/o L-21, New Mahavir Nagar, New Delhi-110018 has stated that the son Sh. Kuldeep Kumar Chanana R/o L-21, New Mahavir Nagar, New Delhi-110018 had borrowed 11 lakhs from him and had so far not returned money. Hence, he wanted his son to vacate above mentioned property no. L-21, New Mahavir Nagar, New Delhi-110018. Sh. Om Parkash Chanana also made allegation of threatful, intimidating and abusive behavior of the respondent son Sh. Kuldeep Kumar Chanana.

During the hearings, Respondent son Sh. Kuldeep Kumar Chanana denied all allegations of threatening, intimidating, abusive behavior on his part towards the petitioner father Sh. Om Parkash Chanana and to support his statement, he also brought his mother Smt. Vidhyawati wife of the Petitioner Sh. Om Parkash Chanana, his sister Ms. Usha Sethi and Ms. Neelam Kalra. All the three supported the Respondent Sh. Kuldeep Kumar Chanana and gave written statement denying all the allegations on the part of the Respondent Sh. Kuldeep Kumar Chanana except the

monetary transaction between the petitioner and the Respondent and stated that he was a good son, looking well after his mother and other relatives and discharging his social responsibilities and also stated that due to old age the petitioner Sh. Om Parkash Chanana had odd behavior and may require medical intervention.

After hearing, all the parties and going through the documents and conciliation efforts made by the Tribunal Members a mutually acceptable proposal was reached upon.

The Tribunal orders as under:-

1. Respondent son Sh. Kuldeep Kumar Chanana shall look after all the requirements of the petitioner father Sh. Om Parkash Chanana as long as the petitioner is alive.
2. Sh. Kuldeep Kumar Chanana's behavior shall always be respectful, careful towards the petitioner father Sh. Om Parkash Chanana.
3. The Respondent Sh. Kuldeep Kumar Chanana shall return the money borrowed from his father in an years time i.e. by 31/03/2015.

The Case is closed accordingly.
