The petitioner has appeared before the Tribunal today along with her son Dr. Adarsh Kapoor who is NRI and settled in USA for past 28 years. He is a practicing Neuro Surgeon in USA.

After hearing the statements of both, this is a case of domestic friction between mother & son. The petitioner is receiving a widow pension of Rs 7000/- per month. Her husband was class II officer in MES (MIL Engineering Services), she is staying at Janakpuri with one of her family acquaintances Shri Vineet Sethi, B-2/43, Janakpuri, New Delhi.

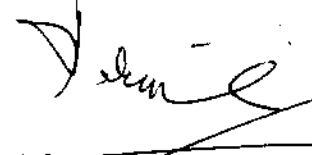
The respondent, Dr. Adarsh Kapoor is not in a position to ~~reconcile~~ reconcile and give any kind of monetary help due to extreme strained relations between mother & son. However he is ready to take her ~~son~~ to USA and look after her. But the mother, Smt. Shekhar Devi has refused to go with him.

The Tribunal is of the view that since the petitioner is a pensioner and is entitled to free medical care through CGHS, maintenance allowance can not be fixed in this case.

The case is closed for further hearing.

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
